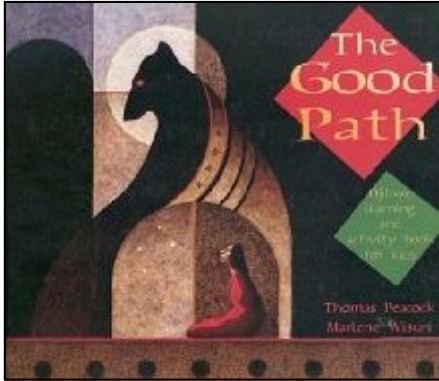

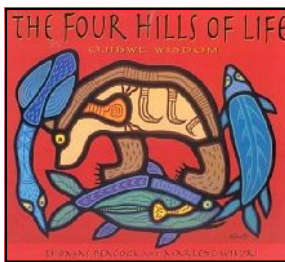


THE GOOD PATH: OJIBWE LEARNING AND ACTIVITY BOOK FOR KIDS

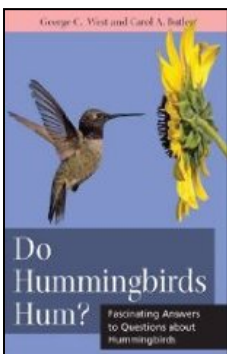
